In 2013, the newly formed Washington Heritage Museums received by deed of gift four 18th century properties in Fredericksburg, VA. These include the Hugh Mercer Apothecary Shop, the Mary Washington House, the Rising Sun Tavern, and St. James' House. The 501c3 owns and maintains these four museums, three of which are open year-round. St. James' House, which also houses Washington Heritage Museums' offices, is open for public tours two weeks each year. The organization has an active membership which spans across the nation.

Our Mission

The mission of Washington Heritage Museums is to preserve, promote and maintain its four 18th century properties in Fredericksburg, Virginia and develop dynamic educational resources and programs to engage and inspire the interest of everyone.

Event Vision

Washington Heritage Museums introduced this event in 2015 to raise local familiarity with its four museums, presenting our museums in an engaging community event.
